We want to first recognize the efforts you have made saving and healing thousands of lives through organ and tissue donation. From participation in the Health Resources and Services Administration's Workplace Partnership for Life program, flag-raising ceremonies and community events, all the way to the critical referrals made to organ procurement organizations, your contributions matter. Collectively, you aided in nearly 2,500 lifesaving organ transplants in 2020, along with countless procedures to restore sight and mobility.

However, we still face significant challenges. Nearly 9,000 New Yorkers are currently waiting for organ transplants, while only 43% of the state's eligible population are enrolled in the New York State Donate Life Registry. New York's Registry ranks 50th out of 52 Donate Life registries in the nation. It will take our collaborative efforts to turn these numbers around and ensure more people receive that important phone call that a

lifesaving organ has become available for transplant.

To that end, HANYS and Donate Life New York State are proud to introduce new and innovative tools for hospitals to use in their campaigns to increase enrollment in the Registry. The newly launched NYS Donate Life Registry Partner Portal provides hospitals with custom online enrollment resources, including trackable URLs and the ability to embed the Registry enrollment form on organizational websites. Most notably, we've seen great success in placing these donor registration opportunities on patient portals for visibility and easy access.

It is our sincere hope that your hospital will join us in taking another step forward in this lifesaving mission to ensure a transplant for every New Yorker in need. Inside the Partner Portal toolkit you will find a "step by step" guide to acquiring and utilizing these resources within your






By embracing organ and tissue donation as a core value of your trusted institutions, hospitals and healthcare systems help create a donation-friendly New York.

on your patient portals and websites


Embedding the Registry's enrollment form allows your patients and the public to register as an organ and tissue donor without ever leaving your hospital's or healthcare system's website or patient portal.

Integration is SIMPLE

short custom code that displays the Registry's enrollment form directly on your patient portals and websites. The custom code contains elements that allow the Registry to know which online enrollments came from your hospital or healthcare system.

The University of Rochester Medical Center (URMC) developed an innovative way to use their trackable resources, and was the first healthcare institution in NY to integrate a Registry enrollment opportunity within their MyChart patient portal. This approach has made a significant impact - enrollments through patient portals comprise half of all enrollments generated by NYS Donate Life Registry Partners.

All hospitals and healthcare systems are encouraged to add this simple and logical donor enrollment opportunity to their patient portals. If your organization uses Epic, please contact your Epic representative and mention: SLG 5989382

GENERATING REPORTS

As a NYS Donate Life Registry Partner, your hospital or healthcare system can generate de-identified report on the Registry's website by simply entering a partner code provided to your organization by Donate Life NYS. This report allows your organization to measure the success of its outreach efforts, detailing the number of enrollments generated through your trackable embedded NYS Donate Life Registry enrollment forms.

"We have learned that a person's attention to the importance of organ and tissue donation can be enhanced through a healthcare experience. A study done by one of our transplant surgeons, Dr. Randeep Kashyap, demonstrated that persons were more likely to enroll in the Donate Life Registry when offered the opportunity during a primary care office visit than when offered the opportunity through other venues such as the DMV. Partners

Welcome to the New York State Donate Life Registry Partner Portal. The New York State Donate Life Registry (Registry) is a secure, confidential database of individuals who have authorized the donation of their organs and tissues after their death for the purpose(s) of transplantation and/or research. The Registry is an important resource that helps address the shortage of organs needed for lifesaving transplants.

Partners of the Registry, play a significant role in helping spread the word about the importance of organ, eye and tissue donation, the importance of enrolling in the Registry and in saving lives by increasing the number of registered organ and tissue donors. Partners are provided customized Registry enrollment tools, including trackable URLs and/or the ability to embed the Registry enrollment form on their organizational websites. Partners are able to track enrollments through de-identified reports that are available by logging into their online partner portal below. Data available to partners includes the number of individuals who have joined the Registry through their organizational website in total or during a specified date range. This allows our partners to measure the impact of their enrollment efforts.

How to Become a Partner

Becoming a partner is a three-step process.

- 1. Submit Part 1 of the Partner Application Form online—see link below
- 2. Complete and submit Part 2 of the Partner Application Form sent to you from the Registry within 60 days of its receipt
- 3. Follow the technical instructions provided by the Registry to establish your custom URL and/or embed the Registry Enrollment Form iframe on your website when they are provided.



REPORTING

- 1. Determine who within your hospital or healthcare system is the appropriate contact (for URMC it was their Chief Operating Officer).
- 2. Visit **donatelife.ny.gov/partners** to begin the partner application process by clicking "Apply as a Partner" and completing the webform. **When completing the webform**, **check both boxes under "Enrollment Resource Requested."**
- 3. Following submission of the webform, you organization's contact will be emailed a questionnaire for completion. Return this questionnaire within 30 days.
- 4. After your application is approved by the Department of Health, Donate Life NYS will contact your organization and schedule a conference call or video chat to discuss implementation details.
- Once implemented, evaluate your success at donatelife.ny.gov/partner-reporting.

Janella Bryant was the mother of four young children, engaged to be married, working full-time, and attending nursing school when, in 2008, she suddenly began having severe back pain and noticed blood in her urine. She visited a urologist, who diagnosed her with nephritis. Her disease progressed quickly, and less than a year later Janella found herself in kidney failure. She began hemodialysis, requiring a time commitment of three times a week for 3-5 hours a day.



Shortly after beginning dialysis, Janella had to make the difficult decision to leave her job and withdraw from school. She said, "I went from being a completely healthy person to having kidney disease, just like that."

When her fiancé died suddenly and unexpectedly, she worried more than ever about leaving her children behind. "I feared all the time, what if something happened to me? What would happen to my kids?"

During her time on dialysis, Janella suffered complications including



shakes, chills, cramps, and even seizures. Finally, after four long years, Janella received her kidney transplant on July 19, 2014.

Janella's transplant allowed her to return to nursing school, from which she graduated in 2017. Following graduation, she worked as a nurse for St. Peter's Health Partners and Albany Medical Center. She is focusing on keeping her new kidney healthy so she can stay with her four children for a very long time. She shares her story so people understand that "this can happen to anyone."
